

Ordinance #191

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE HOUSTON LEVEE AND THE AREA IMMEDIATELY ADJACENT TO SAID LEVEE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF:

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOUSTON ORDAINS:

Whereas, the City of Houston maintains and controls the Houston flood control levee where it parallels the Root River and also extends east and west of County Highway 76 and north and south of MN Highway 16, and regulations of the use of the same are necessary to protect the public safety and welfare, The City Council of the City of Houston does ordain:

Section 1: No motorized vehicle shall be allowed at any time on the structure of the levee or the adjacent banks, without the express permission of the City Administrator and/or the Houston City Council;

Section 2: This ordinance shall not apply to employees of the city of Houston or its employs while they are in performance of their duties;


Section 3: Any person violating the conditions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor and shall be subject to the fines thereof. Ordinance 191 shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage (March 13,2000) and this publication by law.
